This final payment cannot be mailed to the office.

After your application has been received:

1. You will receive an email with instructions about your interview date and time. Thank you for your cooperation.
2. Interview Week for New CYIA Applicants: From Friday, May 17 to Saturday, May 25, 2024 - Parent must be present during the interview.
3. Interview Week for Past Summer Missionaries: From Friday, May 3 to Saturday, May 11, 2024.

You must pay the CYIA Registration Fee on the day of your interview.

Be prepared to inform your interviewers of any other work schedules, sports, family vacations, recitals, or outings you plan on participating in during the Pre-Training Workshops or 5-Day Club work weeks schedule.

4. After your initial interview, your Wayne County Committee member interviewers will submit your name and discuss your interview session with the other Wayne County Committee members. Upon considering your application, a vote is taken to either receive or not to accept your application. If your application is not accepted this year, you will receive your application fee back.

5. You will receive an email acceptance letter no later than ten days after your interview.
6. **Saturday PRE-TRAINING SESSIONS attendance is mandatory for every CYIA student.** These sessions will be on **June 1, June 8, and June 15, 2024**, and are organized by your local CEF Wayne County Chapter. Each session will run from **9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**
 - Wordless Book Training and practice evaluation
 - Recite CYIA Verses on the Verse List
 - Complete all of the CYIA Bible Lesson Study Question pages
 - Read through the Missionary Story
7. **You must attend our MANDATORY Hiring Papers session, if you plan to be hired by CEF.** Your CEF Wayne County Chapter Hiring papers will be available to you at **your first Pre-Training Session on June 1, 2024. If you are a minor your parent must attend this session.**
 - ❖ Hiring Paper Session: **Saturday, June 1, 2024, at 2:00 p.m.**
8. **All paperwork and pretraining requirements must be to the CYIA Registrar by Saturday, JUNE 15, 2024. Also, CYIA Training School FULL PAYMENT IS DUE ON JUNE 15, 2024.**
9. **Please be aware that if you become a summer missionary this year, your 5-Day Club work schedule would be:**
 - Week 1- July 8 to July 12**
 - Week 2- July 15 to July 19**
 - Week 3- July 22 to July 26**
 - Week 4- July 29 to Aug. 2**
